Whenever a private sale is ordered, the order of sale shall

Designate the person authorized to make the sale;

Describe real property to be sold, by reference or otherwise, sufficiently to identify it;

Describe personal property to be sold, by reference or otherwise, sufficiently to indicate its nature and quantity; and

Prescribe such terms of sale as the judge or clerk of court ordering the sale deems advisable.
