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§ 1-339.41(a) An execution sale is a sale of property by a sheriff or other officer made pursuant to an execution.

§ 1-339.41(b) As used in this article,

(1) "Sale" means an execution sale;

(2) "Sheriff" means a sheriff or any officer authorized to hold an execution sale.
