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§ 1-567.48(a) The parties shall be treated with equality and each party shall be given a full opportunity to present its case.

§ 1-567.48(b) A party has the right to be represented by an attorney at any proceeding or hearing under this Article. A waiver of this right prior to the proceeding or hearing is ineffective.
