This Article governs an agreement to arbitrate made on or after January 1, 2004.
- § 1-569.3(b)

This Article governs an agreement to arbitrate made before January 1, 2004, if all parties to the agreement or to the arbitration proceeding agree in a record that this Article applies.
- § 1-569.3(c)

This Article does not govern arbitrations under Article 1H of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes.
