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The following definitions apply in this Article:

Foreign law. - A law, rule, resolution, legal code, legal system, or any component of a legal system established and used or applied in a foreign venue or forum.

Foreign venue or forum. - A venue or forum operating under the authority of a government other than any of the following:

- a.The United States.
- b.A state, district, commonwealth, territory, or insular possession of the United States.
- c.Any other government with regard to which the decision in this State as to whether to recognize a judgment of that government's courts is initially subject to determination under the Full Faith and Credit Clause of the United States Constitution.

Fundamental constitutional right. - A fundamental right of a natural person guaranteed by the United States Constitution or the North Carolina Constitution. (2013-416, s. 1.)
