The Secretary may refuse to issue a license to an applicant that has done any of the following:

Had a license or registration issued under this Article or former Article 36 or 36A of this Chapter revoked by the Secretary.

Had a motor fuel license or registration issued by another state revoked.

Had a federal Certificate of Registry issued under § 4101 of the Code, or a similar federal authorization, revoked.

Been convicted of fraud or misrepresentation.

Been convicted of any other offense that indicates that the applicant may not comply with this Article if issued a license.

Failed to remit payment for a tax debt under Chapter 105 or Chapter 119 of the General Statutes. The term "tax debt" has the same meaning as defined in G.S. 105-243.1.

Failed to file a return due under Chapter 105 or Chapter 119 of the General Statutes.
