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§ 106-1028(a) The General Assembly hereby levies an assessment on all primary forest products harvested from lands within the State of North Carolina.

§ 106-1028(b) This assessment shall be at the rates as established in G.S. 106-1030(b) and the proceeds of such assessment shall be deposited in the Forest Development Fund.
