- To distribute an unregistered soil additive;
 - To distribute an unlabeled soil additive;
 - To distribute a misbranded soil additive;
 - To distribute an "adulterated" soil additive;
 - To fail to comply with a "stop sale, use or removal" order; or
 - To fail to submit semiannual reports.
