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The following definitions apply in this Article:

Case Review Multidisciplinary Team. - An adult protection multidisciplinary team that reviews selected active cases in which disabled adults and older adults are being served by adult protective services through a local department of social services.

Director of social services. - As defined by G.S. 108A-74.

Disabled adult. - An individual 18 years of age or older or a lawfully emancipated minor who is present in the State of North Carolina and who is physically or mentally incapacitated, as defined in G.S. 108A-101(d).

Older adult. - An individual 65 years of age or older.

Systemic Review Multidisciplinary Team. - An adult protection multidisciplinary team that works together to do all of the following:

- a.Address systemic problems and service gaps that may exist in the delivery of services to disabled adults or older adults by public and nonpublic agencies.
- b.Develop information networks.
- c.Provide coordinated community education and outreach designed to protect against abuse, neglect, and exploitation of disabled adults or older adults. (2025-23, s. 1.)
