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§ 108D-5.5(a) In General. - A PHP requesting disenrollment of an enrollee from the PHP shall submit a written request for disenrollment to the enrollment broker.

§ 108D-5.5(b) Limitations on PHP Requests for Disenrollment. - A PHP shall not request disenrollment of an enrollee from the PHP for any reason prohibited by 42 C.F.R. § 438.56(b)(2). A PHP may request disenrollment of an enrollee only when both of the following criteria are met:

- (1) The enrollee's behavior seriously hinders the PHP's ability to care for the enrollee or other enrollees of the PHP.
- (2) The PHP has documented efforts to resolve the issues that form the basis of the request for disenrollment of the enrollee. (2019-81, s. 1(a).)
