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Every application for a notary commission shall be made on paper with original signatures, or in another form determined by the Secretary, and shall include all of the following:

- A statement of the applicant's personal qualifications as required by this Chapter.
- A certificate or signed statement by the instructor evidencing successful completion of the course of instruction as required by this Chapter.
- A notarized declaration of the applicant, as required by this Chapter.
- Any other information that the Secretary deems appropriate.
- The application fee required by this Chapter. (2005-391, s. 4.)
