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§ 110-103(a) Any person who violates the provisions of G.S. 110-98 shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. Violations of G.S. 110-98(2), 110-99(b), 110-99(c), and 110-102 are exempted from the provisions of this subsection.

§ 110-103(b)
CLASS I FELONY It shall be a Class I felony for any person who operates a child care facility to:

- (1) Willfully violate the provisions of G.S. 110-99(a), or
- (2) Willfully violate the provisions of this Article while providing child care for three or more children, for more than four hours per day on two consecutive days.

§ 110-103(c)
CLASS H FELONY Any person who violates the provisions of this Article and, as a result of the violation, causes serious injury to a child attending the child care facility, shall be guilty of a Class H felony.

§ 110-103(d)
CLASS H FELONY Any person who violates subsection (a) of this section, and has a prior conviction for violating subsection (a), shall be guilty of a Class H felony.
