No landscape contractor shall use oyster shells as a ground cover.

Enforcement of the prohibition set forth in this section shall be under the jurisdiction of the Marine Fisheries Commission.
- § 113-270(c)

For purposes of this section, landscape contractor shall have the definition set forth in G.S. 89D-11. (2015-241, s. 14.7(a).)
