- The requirements of this Article do not authorize a parent to do any of the following:
- (1)

Engage in unlawful conduct.
- (2)

Abuse or neglect the child, as defined in Chapter 7B of the General Statutes.

- § 114A-15(b)
- The requirements of this Article do not prohibit the following:
- (1)

A State official or employee from acting in his or her official capacity within the reasonable and prudent scope of his or her authority.
- (2)

A court of competent jurisdiction from acting in its official capacity within the reasonable and prudent scope of its authority or issuing an order otherwise permitted by law. (2023-106, s. 1.)
