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§ 115C-238.52(a) Any or all of the following education partners may participate in the development of a cooperative innovative high school under this Part that is targeted to high school students who would benefit from accelerated academic instruction:

- (1) , (2) Repealed by Session Laws 2005-276, s. 7.33(a), effective July 1, 2005.
- (3) A private business or organization.
- (4) The county board of commissioners in the county in which the cooperative innovative high school is located.

§ 115C-238.52(b) Any or all of the education partners listed in subsection (a) of this section that participate shall:

- (1) Jointly apply with the local board of education and the local board of trustees to establish a cooperative innovative high school under this Part.
- (2) Be identified in the application.
- (3) Sign the written agreement under G.S. 115C-238.53(b). (2003-277, s. 2; 2005-276, s. 7.33(a); 2012-142, s. 7.11(d).)
