§ 115C-299(a) Teachers shall be elected by the local boards of education upon the recommendation of the superintendent.

§ 115C-299(b) No person otherwise qualified shall be denied the right to receive credentials from the State Board of Education, to receive training for the purpose of becoming a teacher, or to engage in practice teaching in any school on the grounds that the person is totally or partially blind; nor shall any local board of education refuse to employ the person on these grounds.

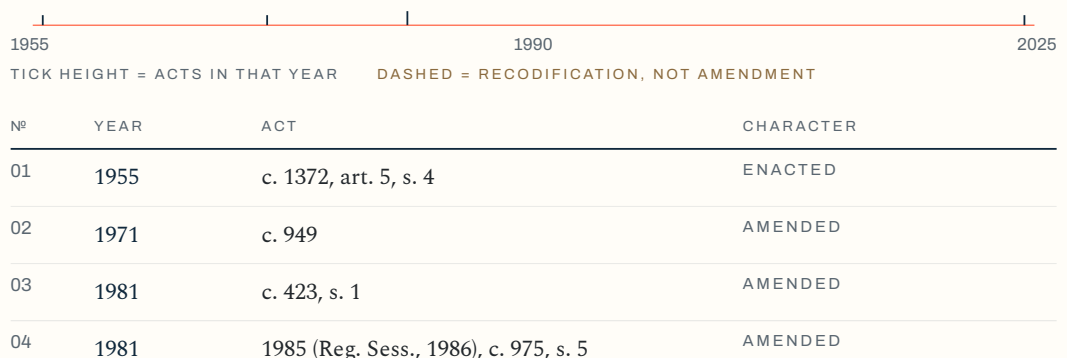
