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§ 115D-10.5(a) New Programs and Terminations of Programs. - A community college may not of -
fer a new program without the approval of the State Board of Community Colleges
except that approval shall not be required if the tuition for the program will fully
cover the cost of the program. If at any time tuition fails to fully cover the cost of
a program that falls under the exception, the program shall be discontinued unless
approved by the State Board. If a proposed new program would serve more than one
community college, the State Board shall perform a feasibility study prior to acting
on the proposal. The State Board shall consider whether a regional approach can be
used when developing new programs and, to the extent possible, shall initiate new
programs on a regional basis. The State Board shall collect data on an annual basis
on all new programs and program terminations it approved and any regionalization of
programs during the year, including the specific reasons for which each program was
terminated or approved.

§ 115D-10.5(b) Recreation Extension Courses. - Funds appropriated to the Community Colleges
System Office as operating expenses for allocation to the institutions comprising the
North Carolina Community College System shall not be used to support recreation
extension courses. The financing of these courses by any institution shall be on a
self-supporting basis, and membership hours produced from these activities shall
not be counted when computing full-time equivalent students (FTE) for use in
budget-funding formulas at the State level.

§ 115D-10.5(c)

Real Estate Continuing Education Courses. - Whenever a community college of -
fers real estate continuing education courses, the courses shall be offered on a
self-supporting basis. (2025-56, s. 1(a).)
