ARTICLE 1 - GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR STATE ADMINISTRATION

N.C.G.S. § 115D-10.65.

Accreditation of secondary school located in North Carolina shall not be a factor in admissions, loans, scholarships, or other educational policies.

§ 115D-10.65(a) For purposes of this section, the term "accreditation" shall include certification or any other similar approval process.

§ 115D-10.65(b) The State Board of Community Colleges shall adopt a policy that prohibits any community college from soliciting or using information regarding the accreditation of a secondary school located in North Carolina that a person attended as a factor affecting admissions, loans, scholarships, or other educational activity at the community college, unless the accreditation was conducted by a State agency.
