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The following definitions apply to this Part:

Eligible postsecondary institution. - A school that is:

- a.A constituent institution of The University of North Carolina as defined in G.S. 116-2(4).
- b.A community college as defined in G.S. 115D-2(2).

Matriculated status. - Being recognized as a student in a defined program of study leading to a degree, diploma, or certificate at an eligible postsecondary institution.

Program. - The North Carolina Need-Based Scholarship Program for Public Colleges and Universities.

Reserve Fund. - Scholarship Reserve Fund for Public Colleges and Universities.

Scholarship. - A scholarship for education awarded under this Part.
