ARTICLE 3 - GASOLINE AND OIL INSPECTION

N.C.G.S. § 119-15.1.

List of persons who must have a license.

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§ 119-15.1(a) License. - A person may not engage in business in this State as any of the following unless the person has a license issued by the Secretary authorizing the person to engage in business:

- (1) A kerosene supplier.
- (2) A kerosene distributor.
- (3) A kerosene terminal operator.
- (4) A dyed diesel fuel distributor.

§ 119-15.1(b) Exception. - A kerosene supplier license is not required if the supplier is licensed as a supplier under Part 2 of Article 36C of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes. A kerosene distributor is required to have a kerosene distributor license only if the distributor imports kerosene. Other kerosene distributors may elect to have a kerosene license. A kerosene terminal operator license is not required if the terminal operator is licensed as a terminal operator under Part 2 of Article 36C of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes.
