Any person, not specifically authorized by G.S. 126-24 to have access to a personnel file designated as conf -
idential by this Article, who shall knowingly and willfully examine in its official filing place, remove or copy
any portion of a confidential personnel file shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor and upon conviction
shall only be fined in the discretion of the court but not in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
