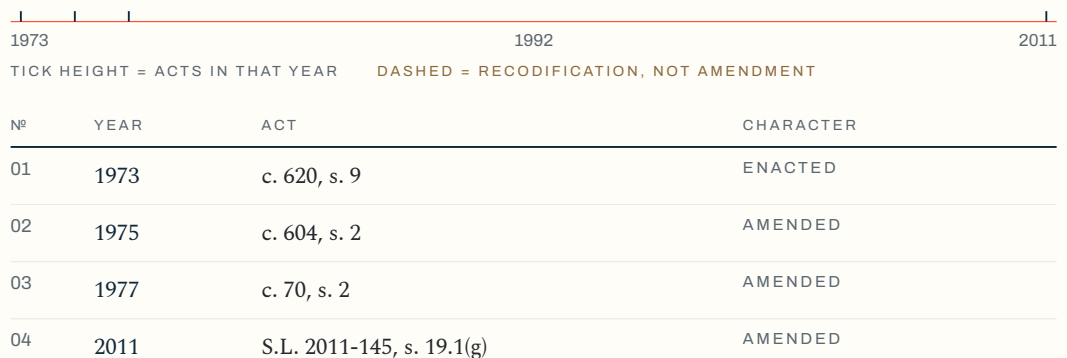
Administrative and operational relationships of the Adjutant General.
