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§ 127B-36(a) Civil Action. - A servicemember aggrieved by a person's violation of any provision of this Article may commence a civil action against that person.

§ 127B-36(b) Remedies. - The court may order any of the following remedies:

- (1) Injunction.
- (2) Payment of restitution to a servicemember in the amount of money unlawfully received from, or required to be refunded to, the servicemember.
- (3) Damages.
- (4) Any other remedy provided under Chapter 75 of the General Statutes.

§ 127B-36(c) Costs. - A servicemember who prevails in an action under this section may recover attorneys' fees and court costs. (2019-161, s. 1(a).)
