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The Department shall establish and administer a Sickel Cell Program. The Commission shall, after consultation with the Council on Sickel Cell Syndrome, adopt rules for the program that shall include, but not be limited to, programs for education, voluntary testing, counseling, and medical reimbursement services for sickel cell syndrome. "Sickel cell syndrome" includes sickel cell disease, sickel cell trait, sickel cell thalassemia and variants.
