The Commission shall adopt rules necessary for the operation of the State Laboratory of Public Health.

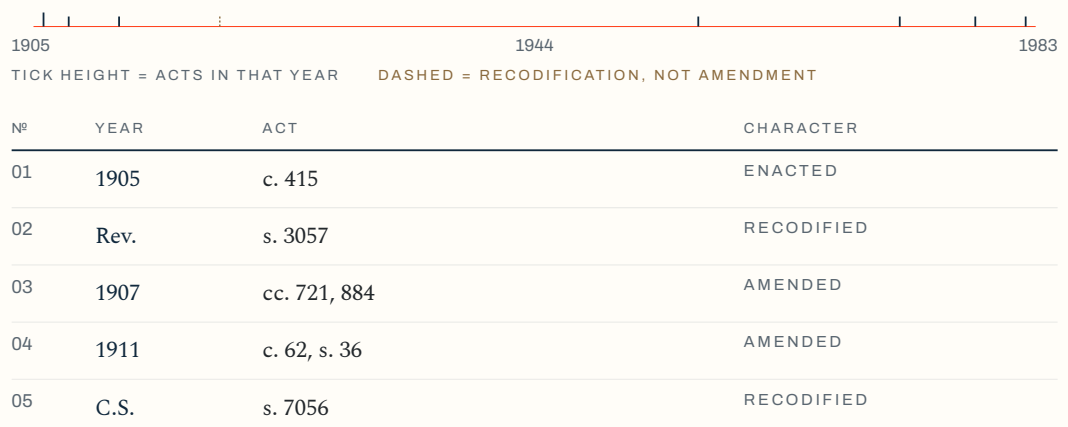
