The Commission is authorized to establish reasonable standards governing the nature and scope of public health services rendered by local health departments.

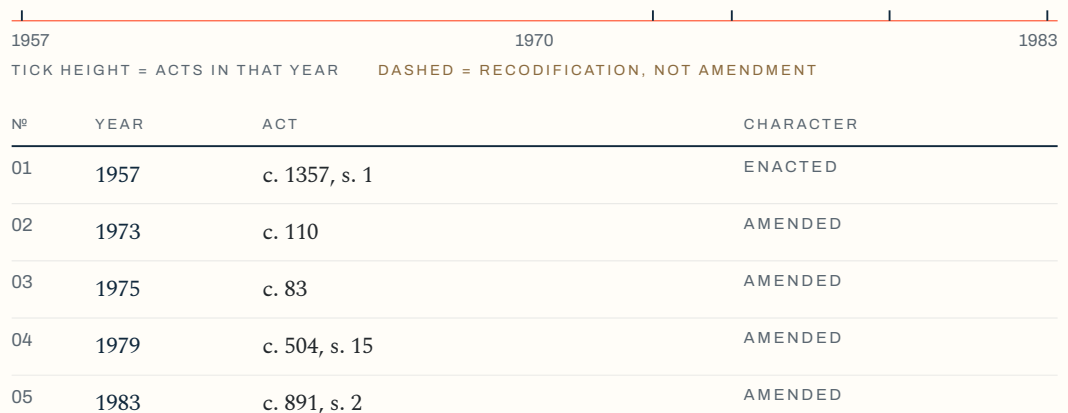
