- § 131E-40(a)

This Part shall be known as the "Hospital District Act."
- § 131E-40(b)

It is the purpose of this Part to authorize the creation of hospital districts to furnish hospital, clinical and similar services to the people of this State.
- § 131E-40(c)

This Part provides an additional and alternative method for the provision of hospital, clinical and similar services.
- § 131E-40(d)

This Part shall be construed liberally to effect its purposes.
