Placing glass, etc., or injurious obstructions in road.

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- § 136-91(a)

No person shall throw, place, or deposit any glass or other sharp or cutting substance or any injurious obstruction in or upon any highway or public vehicular area.
- § 136-91(b)

As used in this section:

(1) "Highway" shall be defined as it is in G.S. 20-4.01; and

(2) "Public vehicular area" shall be defined as it is in G.S. 20-4.01.
- § 136-91(c)

Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor.
