Any person who shall willfully burn or destroy any other person's lawfully grown crop, pasture, or provender shall be punished as follows:

If the damage is two thousand dollars (\$2,000) or less, the person is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.

If the damage is more than two thousand dollars (\$2,000), the person is guilty of a Class I felony.
