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§ 14-190.17C(a)

CLASS E FELONY

It is a Class E felony for any person to knowingly produce, distribute, receive, or possess with intent to distribute material that meets both of the following criteria:

- (1) Depicts a minor engaging in sexual activity.
- (2) Is obscene.

§ 14-190.17C(b)

CLASS H FELONY

It is a Class H felony for any person to knowingly possess material that meets both of the following criteria:

- (1) Depicts a minor engaging in sexual activity.
- (2) Is obscene.

§ 14-190.17C(c)

It is not a required element of any offense under this section that the minor depicted actually exist. (2024-37, s. 2(e).)
