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Any person who does any of the following is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor:

Violates any provision of an ordinance or a declaration enacted or declared pursuant to G.S. 166A-19.31.

Violates any provision of a declaration or executive order issued pursuant to G.S. 166A-19.30.

Willfully refuses to leave the building as directed in a Governor's order issued pursuant to G.S. 166A-19.78.- (2012-12, s. 1(d).)
