This Article provides supplemental pension benefits for all county sheriffs who are retired from the Local Governmental Employees' Retirement System or an equivalent locally sponsored plan as herein described.
- § 143-166.81(b)

The North Carolina Department of Justice shall administer the provisions of this Article.
- § 143-166.81(c)

The provisions of this Article shall be subject to future legislative change or revision, and no person is deemed to have acquired any vested right to a pension payment provided by this Article.
