Nothing in this Article shall be construed to:

Grant to the Commission any jurisdiction or authority with respect to air contamination existing solely within commercial and industrial plants, works or shops;

Affect the relations between employers and employees with respect or arising out of conditions of air contamination or air pollution;

Supersede or limit the applicability of any law, rules and regulations or ordinances relating to industrial health or safety.
