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The Governor, before granting written approval of any such contract, must find:

That the contract is reasonably necessary to the proper function of such State agency; and

That such services or advice cannot be performed within the resources of such State agency;

That the estimated cost is reasonable as compared with the likely benefits or results; and

That the General Assembly has appropriated funds for such contract or that such funds are otherwise available; and

That all rules and regulations of the Department of Administration have been or will be complied with.
