The Commission shall meet quarterly, and at any other such time that it shall deem necessary. Meetings may be called by the chairman or by a petition signed by a majority of the members of the Commission. Ten days' notice shall be given in writing prior to the meeting date.
- § 143B-408(b)

Simple majority of the Indian members of the Commission must be present to constitute a quorum.
- § 143B-408(c)

Proxy vote shall not be permitted.
