§ 143B-603.1(a) Establishment of Fund. - The Continuously Operating Reference Station (CORS) Fund is established as a special revenue fund. The Fund consists of General Fund appropriations, gifts, donations, grants, devises, fees, and monies contributed by State and non-State entities for the operation, maintenance, and expansion of the North Carolina CORS/Real Time Network (RTN) operated and maintained by the North Carolina Geodetic Survey and any other revenues specifically allocated to the Fund by an act of the General Assembly.

§ 143B-603.1(b) Uses of Fund. - Revenue credited to the Fund may only be used for costs associated with CORS/RTN operations, maintenance, and expansion. (2022-58, s. 3(a).)
