The North Carolina State Ports Authority in exercising its powers under G.S. 136-260 through G.S. 136-275.

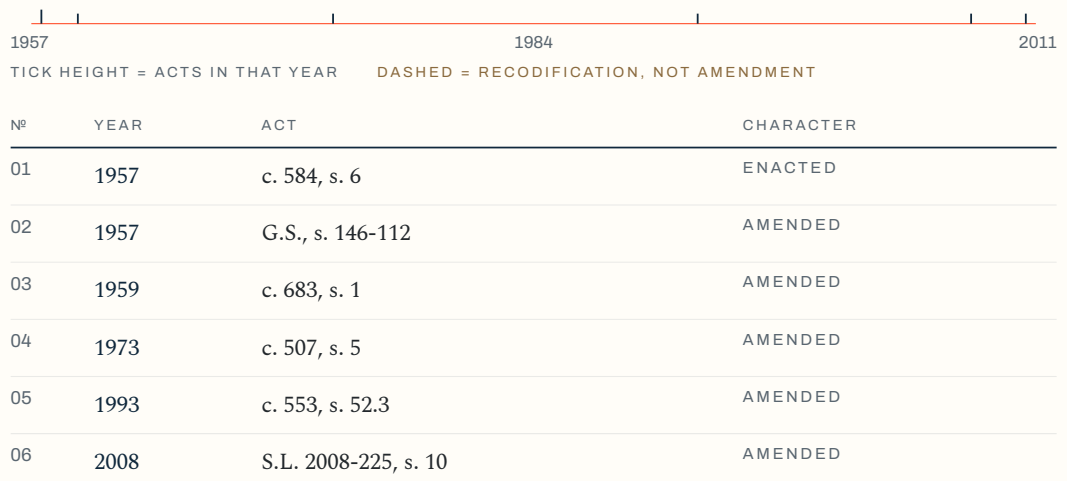
