Correction Enterprises shall serve all of the following purposes to:

- Provide incarcerated offenders a work and training environment that emulates private industry.
- Provide incarcerated offenders with training opportunities that allow them to increase work skills and employability upon release from prison.
- Provide quality goods and services.
- Aid victims by contributing a portion of its proceeds to the Crime Victims Compensation Fund.
- Generate sufficient funds from the sale of goods and services to be a self-supporting operation. (2007-280, s. 1.)
