The board of commissioners shall adopt a resolution or policy containing a code of ethics, as required by G.S. 160A-86.
- § 153A-53(b)

All members of the board of commissioners, whether elected or appointed, shall receive the ethics education required by G.S. 160A-87. (2009-403, s. 4.)
