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§ 163-232.2(a) Each county board of elections shall report the following to the State Board during each day of the early voting period:

- (1) The number of mail-in absentee ballots that have been spoiled due to the voter voting in person at an early voting site after requesting a mail-in absentee ballot.
- (2) The number of outstanding mail-in absentee ballots, including the total number of mail-in absentee ballots sent to date and the total number of mail-in absentee ballots received to date.

§ 163-232.2(b) Each county board of elections shall report the following to the State Board on the day after the day of the election:

- (1) The number of mail-in absentee ballots that have been counted.
- (2) The number of outstanding mail-in absentee ballots, including the total number of mail-in absentee ballots sent to date and the total number of mail-in absentee ballots received to date.
- (3) The number of provisional ballots cast.

§ 163-232.2(c) The reports required by this section shall be completed in the manner specified by the State Board. The State Board shall publish each report received by a county board of elections pursuant to this section on its website each day. Each list shall be made publicly available and shall be published in a readable and usable format. (2023-140, s. 35.)
