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§ 166A-19.4(a) No United States citizen, United States national, or qualified alien as defined in 8 U.S.C. § 1641 shall be denied or discriminated against by the State or its agencies and employees for disaster recovery assistance on the basis of political affiliation or political speech.

§ 166A-19.4(b) Any person who knowingly violates this section shall be guilty of a Class I felony.
