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§ 20-12.1(a) It is unlawful for a person to serve as a supervising driver under G.S. 20-7(l) or G.S. 20-11 or as an approved instructor under G.S. 20-7(m) in any of the following circumstances:

- (1) While under the influence of an impairing substance.
- (2) After having consumed sufficient alcohol to have, at any relevant time after the driving, an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more.

§ 20-12.1(b) An offense under this section is an implied-consent offense under G.S. 20-16.2.
