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A person may obtain a duplicate of a license issued by the Division by paying a fee of sixteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$16.75) and giving the Division satisfactory proof that any of the following has occurred:

The person's license has been lost or destroyed.

It is necessary to change the name or address on the license.

Because of age, the person is entitled to a license with a different color photographic background or a different color border.

The Division revoked the person's license, the revocation period has expired, and the period for which the license was issued has not expired.

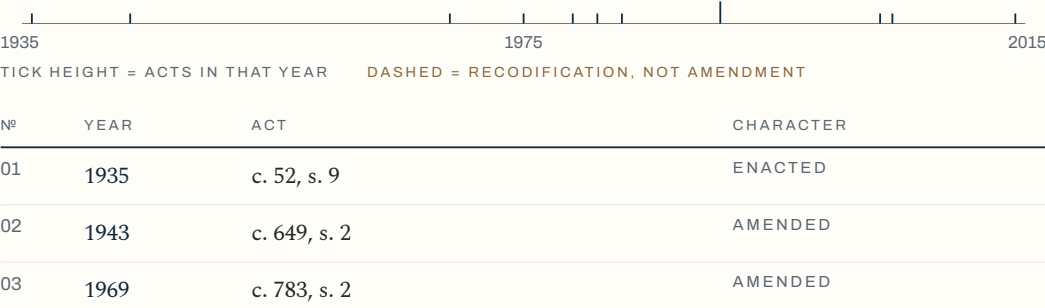
