The following definitions apply in this Article:

Airport operator. - As defined in G.S. 20-280.1.

Peer-to-peer vehicle sharing. - The authorized use of a shared vehicle by an individual other than the shared vehicle owner through a peer-to-peer vehicle sharing program.

Peer-to-peer vehicle sharing program. - A business platform that connects shared vehicle owners with drivers to enable the sharing of vehicles for financial consideration.

Shared vehicle. - A vehicle that is available for sharing through a peer-to-peer vehicle sharing program.

Shared vehicle owner. - The registered owner of a shared vehicle that is made available for sharing through a peer-to-peer vehicle sharing program.

Vehicle sharing provider. - The person or entity that operates, facilitates, or administers the provision of personal vehicle sharing through a peer-to-peer vehicle sharing program. (2019-199, s. 9(a).)
