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A sign, at least 24 inches on each side, shall be posted in a manner conspicuous to the public. The sign shall contain:

That the consumer has a right to receive a written estimate or to waive receipt of that estimate if the cost of repairs will exceed three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00).

That the consumer may request, at the time the work order is taken, the return or inspection of all parts that have been replaced during the motor vehicle repair. (1999-437, s. 1.)
