The following definitions apply in this Article:

Federal safety and hazardous materials regulations. - The federal motor carrier safety regulations contained in 49 C.F.R. Parts 171 through 180, 382, and 390 through 398.

Foreign commerce. - Commerce between any of the following:

- a.A place in the United States and a place in a foreign country.
- b.Places in the United States through any foreign country.

Interstate commerce. - As defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5.

Interstate motor carrier. - Any person, firm, or corporation that operates or controls a commercial motor vehicle as defined in 49 C.F.R. § 390.5 in interstate commerce.

Intrastate commerce. - As defined in 49 C.F.R. Part 390.5.

Intrastate motor carrier. - Any person, firm, or corporation that operates or controls a motor vehicle in intrastate commerce when the vehicle:

- a.Is a vehicle having a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) or gross combination weight rating (GCWR) or gross vehicle weight (GVW) or gross combination weight (GCW) of 26,001 pounds or more, whichever is greater.
- b.Is designed or used to transport 16 or more passengers, including the driver.
- c.Is used in transporting a hazardous material in a quantity requiring placarding pursuant to 49 C.F.R. Parts 170 through 185.

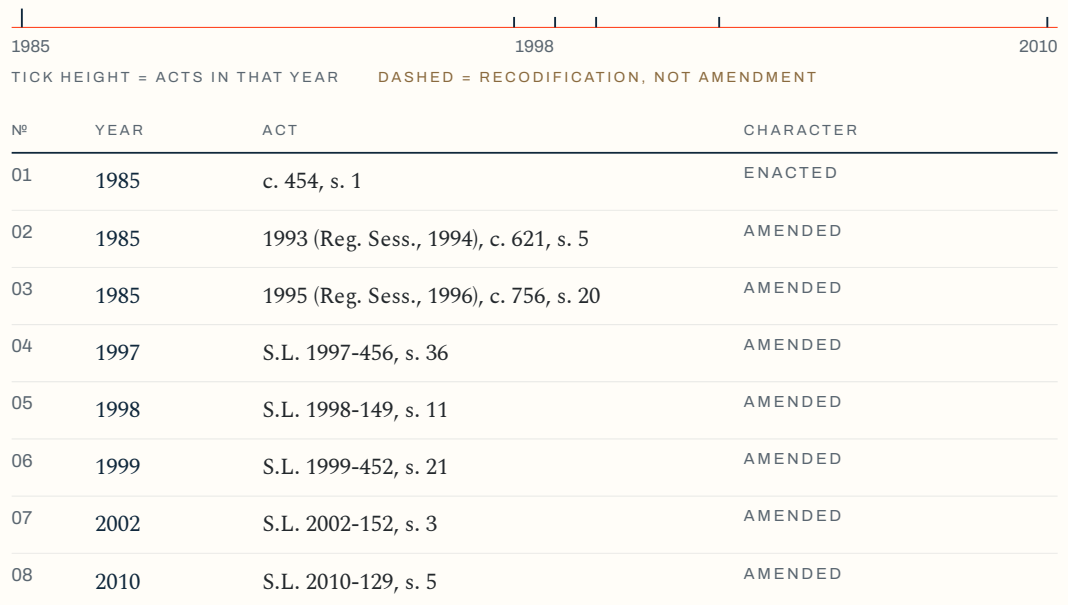
