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§ 25C-13(a) Whenever an art dealer discloses information as required by G.S. 25C-11, such information shall be a part of the basis of the bargain and shall create express warranties as to the information so provided.

§ 25C-13(b) When information is not disclosed as required by G.S. 25C-11, such nondisclosure shall constitute an express warranty that such information is not required to be disclosed.

§ 25C-13(c) Evidence of a warranty made in accordance with this Article shall be prima facie evidence of reliance upon the warranty.
