- § 33A-15(a)

A custodian is entitled to pay from and to be reimbursed from custodial property for reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of the custodian's duties.
- § 33A-15(b)

Except for one who is a transferor under G.S. 33A-4, a custodian has a noncumulative election during each calendar year to charge reasonable compensation for services performed during that year.
- § 33A-15(c)

Except as provided in G.S. 33A-18(f), a custodian need not give a bond.
