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The following definitions apply in this Chapter:

Human trafficking offense. - Any criminal offense under Article 10A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes that is not a sex offense.

Permanent civil no-contact order. - A permanent injunction that prohibits any contact by a respondent with the victim of a human trafficking offense or sex offense for which the respondent is convicted.

Respondent. - The person who committed the human trafficking offense or sex offense.

Sex offense. -- Any criminal offense that requires registration under Article 27A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes.

Victim. - The person against whom the human trafficking offense or sex offense was committed. (2015-91, s. 1; 2023-71, s. 1(a).)
