ARTICLE 23 - CONTINUITY OF CONTRACT UNDER EUROPEAN MONETARY UNION

N.C.G.S. § 53-295.

Definitions.

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The following definitions shall apply in this Article:

Euro. - The currency of participating member states of the European Union that adopt a single currency in accordance with the Treaty on European Union dated February 7, 1992.

European Currency Unit (ECU). - The currency as defined in the European Council regulation number 3320/94.

Introduction of the Euro. - The implementation of economic and monetary union of member states of the European Union in accordance with the Treaty on European Union dated February 7, 1992. (1999-312, s. 1.)
